Introduction to the 40th Anniversary Bursary 2020-2021

In Salesian College our central purpose as a school is education and the foundation of the teachings of Don Bosco are our driving influence.

We pride ourselves in Salesian College in preparing honest and Christian citizens for their next stage in life.

We ultimately hope that all our students will take the ethos of reason love and kindness in to their personal and professional lives and make a positive contribution to society.

As part of the celebrations of the 40th Anniversary of Salesian College the school committee will provide a once off bursary to the value of €2000 to a Leaving Certificate student of Salesian College 2021 This Bursary – the Salesian College 40th Anniversary Bursary 2020-2021 will be awarded to support the third level education and training of the award winner.

The bursary will be awarded on confirmation of the student attending their nominated /accepted third level course.

Formal and certified receipt / documentation must be presented to the school to secure the payment.

This award will be presented on receipt of confirmation of completion of first full year of study.

Salesian College will contact the third level institute with a formal letter acknowledging this award to the student in question.

Source of funding

- This Bursary will be funded by the Trustees – the Salesians of Don Bosco, the Board of Management and the Salesian College Parents Association

Who can apply?

- 6th year Leaving Certificate students of Salesian College 2020.
- Applicants must complete the Leaving Certificate exams in June 2021.

Application process

- Applications will only be accepted on the formal application form which will be available to download from the school web-site www.salesianscelbridge.com on the launch date in December 2020.
- Applications must be word processed and stay within the word limit on the questions. Handwritten applications will not be accepted.
- Times New Roman print – size 12
- Incomplete application forms will be disqualified
- Any changes to the application form will result in disqualification
- Three original signed hard copy application forms must be submitted in a sealed A4 envelope with 40th Anniversary Bursary application clearly written on the envelope and the submission date.
- They must be presented in person to Ms. Kearns, Principal.
- The photograph requested must be a passport style photograph taken within 1 month of the application deadline Friday 29th January, Don Bosco Day in Salesian College.
- Late applications will be not considered.

Selection panel

- The judging panel will consist of 1 representative from the Trustees, the Salesians of Don Bosco.
- Ms. Brenda Kearns, Principal & Secretary to the Board of Management and an Independent Assessor.
- The Board of Management will nominate these panel members. The panel members will have an understanding of the education system whether at primary, post-primary or third level.
- The panel members will individually assess all applications, shortlist the applications and make recommendations for consideration.
- The panel will together review the shortlisted applications and agree the nominated award winner.

Criteria / Selection process

- The winner will demonstrate an understanding of the significance of the school ethos.
- The selection panel will recommend the award winner to the Board of Management.
- The award winner will be announced at the 6th year graduation ceremony in May 2021.
