Dear Parents & Guardians,

Due to circumstances beyond our control in relation to the delivery of our uniforms we will not have the jumpers in stock for collection on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June as previously advised.

Unfortunately, we must postpone the collection of all uniforms until August.

The scheduled date is Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August 6 -7pm.

As there will be larger numbers I will extend this to 8pm.

Previous years have run very efficiently with the assistance of the Parents Association. Each jumper / tie will be labelled and ready for collection. You will be asked to present your receipt as evidence of order and payment. Sample sizes will be available on the night if you wish to change the jumper size you have ordered.

### ***Donations of no-longer needed uniforms***

We are still accepting donations of clean and in good condition secondhand jumpers which can be brought to the school and we will leave for parents & guardians to avail of the evening of Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August.

### ***Book rental scheme***

All parents & guardians have been advised of the new book rental scheme which will operate for all 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> year students for this coming academic year.

All parents & guardians must pay a deposit in order to avail of the school books in August. **Students will not receive their allocated books and stationary for first and second year in August if this deposit is not paid.**

This is our first year organising this new scheme and we will endeavour to be as efficient as possible and we thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding.

We understand that these dates fall during the summer holidays, however given the complexity of the scheme we must ask parents & guardians to call to the school during these times. These books will be scanned and a record kept of the student name and what they have been given.

Due to the large numbers of books and stationery, uncollected books will not be kept on the school premises. Therefore, it is imperative that you make arrangements with either a neighbour or a family friend to collect them on the night on your behalf if you are unable to attend.

### ***School Charge***

All parents & guardians are also reminded of the school charge of €130.00 to be paid for all students. Incoming first year students have already paid this.
